Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you that we have recently achieved the Leading Parent Partnership Award (LPPA). This is in recognition of our commitment to work collaboratively with parents/carers. For the full verification report please see the attached document.

Research has identified that, at age 7, a parent's influence on a child's learning is six times that of their school and even at 11 years old, it is 29% greater. Increased involvement can raise achievement by at least 18%. No involvement means low or no qualifications at 16.

Consequently, we are pleased to achieve the award which demonstrates our commitment to working with parents/carers. As a result of achieving this national award we hope it will:

- contribute to improved pupil attendance, punctuality, behaviour and progress
- increase parent participation and involvement
- enhance parents' support in their children's learning
- improve communication between home and school

Our work with parents/carers continues beyond the achievement of this award and continuing to work with our Parent Forum and parent working party remains a key priority.
