

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Residential Trip: Wednesday 12th February – Friday 14th February 2025

Leaving School at 10.30am on 12th February 2025

Returning for 3pm on Friday 14th June 2025

We are delighted to be able to offer a Residential Trip for Year 6 pupils at Bournville Primary.

We have been very lucky to book Kingswood Adventure Park for this year's residential (less than an hour from school!). The cost of this trip includes all activities, qualified instructors, insurance, accommodation and food. The school is going to cover the cost of the transport.

When we have final numbers, we will arrange a parent meeting to discuss the trip in greater detail, provide a kit list and answer any questions. I understand the worries you may feel with many of the children not having stayed away from home before, but we can assure you they are in safe hands and will have so much fun with the range of different activities the center has to offer. Many pupils (and parents) in Year 6 feel this same worry, however, the best way to view it is the biggest sleepover with their friends! When they are all together, they grow so much, helping each other and encouraging one another to overcome fears. It honestly will be one of their best memories for life!

The cost of this trip is £100 per pupil. If you would like your child to attend this residential, a deposit payment of **£25** is required by **Thursday 31st October 2024**. We have then broken the remaining payments down into monthly installments as follows:

£25 by Saturday 30th November 2024

£25 by Tuesday 31st December 2024

£25 by Friday 31st January 2025

It is essential your payments are made, either in full or in line with the above schedule, to ensure your child's space is secure. If you have any difficulty with funding the full amount of this trip, please speak to Miss Withy as soon as possible.

Places on this residential are subject to exemplary behaviour of your child in school, in order to ensure safety whilst away from school and in a public place. Any children who are unable to follow the school values within school prior to the trip may result in them being removed from the list and the loss of any payment made. Please explain this to your child so they understand the importance of holding a high standard for themselves.

Please note that any request for refunds will be subject to a review of affordability of this trip by the school. This is because some trips require the school to pay non-refundable deposits prior to the trip. If your child is unable to attend the trip at very short notice then please be assured we will always do our best to find a student who can take their place, thus enabling us to afford refunds, but if we are unable to do this then we may be unable to offer refunds.
