Reception Class: Curriculum Overview: Autumn 1, 2024



Literacy

- To understand that print has meaning & naming the different parts of a book (front cover, title, author).
- Finding their name label (photo & name) & practise writing it.
- **Phonics:** Say the sound for: m,a,s,d,t,i,n,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f,e,l,h and begin to write them correctly. Links will be sent on Class Dojo.
- To listen to stories and answer key questions based on VIPERS (see separate sheet).

Physical Development

- Bikeability: Taught in the playground. Aim is to help children to set off, pedal, slow down and stop (including looking behind, cycling one handed, turning and controlling speed).
- Practise putting on own coat and zipping it up.
- Develop hand strengthening skills through a range of fine motor activities.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development



- Manage their own basic personal hygiene & personal needs.
- Begin to explain the reason for rules & know right from wrong by exploring our School Values, Class Rules & Routines.
- Develop their sense of responsibility & membership of the class by taking turns to be the Milk Monitor, Snack Monitor, etc.
- To show an understanding of their own and others' feelings by playing a range of whole class, small group and 1:1 activity.

Understanding the World

- **History:** Bournville School did any of our family members come to Bournville School?
- **Geography:** 'I Spy Around My School' use observational skills to study the school grounds.
- Science: Light and dark: Nocturnal animals, shadow, celebrating with light

Expressive Art and Design

- Self-portraits: To explain the process they use to mix tones and shades for hair, skin and eye colours and looking at the texture of their hair.
