### **Phonics/ Reading**

Read Write Inc. Phonics teaches reading and writing through learning letter sounds and blending them to read words effortlessly. Children learn 44 sounds and corresponding letters using picture prompts, read using Fred Talk and blending, engage with lively stories, and comprehend through 'Find It' and 'Prove It' questions. For writing, they spell effortlessly, learn letter groups representing sounds, write using Fred Talk, create simple to complex sentences, compose various texts, and stories based on picture strips. In reading, they blend sounds from Speed Sound sets to read words, and in writing, they practice sound-blending by saying pure sounds quickly and merging them for the whole word.
