Include at least three animals and explain how they are suited to their habitat.</p>	<p><b>History and Art</b></p> <p>Research the following about Alberto Giacometti and create a fact file. Include illustrations or printed images to make it visually interesting.            Birth and Early Life: When and where was Giacometti born? What was his childhood like?            Career Highlights: What type of art did he create? What is he most famous for?            Artistic Style: Describe his unique style and the materials he used.            Key Works: Find at least one example of his famous sculptures (e.g., Walking Man or Standing Woman) and describe it.            Legacy: Why is his work important today?</p>
