Dear Parents/Carers/Grandparents,

I hope this letter finds you well. We are excited to inform you about an upcoming educational trip to the **ThinkTank Science Museum** for **Years 2, 3, and 5** on **14th March 2025**. This trip will provide a fantastic opportunity for children to engage with interactive exhibits, hands-on learning experiences and workshops that support their understanding of science and technology and enhance their learning.

Schedule: Children will depart from school at **9:15 am** via coach. Please ensure they arrive on time and are dressed in suitable clothing and footwear for the day. We expect to return in time for the normal end of the school day. If there are any changes, updates will be provided via **ClassDojo**.

Meals: Children need to bring a **packed lunch** and a **water bottle**. If your child requires a school-packed lunch, please indicate this on the attached slip.

Cost: The cost of the trip is **£13.50** per child, covering transport and entry to the museum. Payment can be made via ParentPay. ParentPay will open for payment **Wednesday 12th February at 3pm** and close on **Monday 10th March at 3pm**. If you require assistance with ParentPay, please speak to the class teacher.


Consent: Please note that by making payment via Parent Pay you are providing consent for your child to attend the trip. By paying for this trip, you agree to give permission for the staff in charge to act *in loco parentis* if medical treatment is required.

Refunds: Any request for refunds will be subject to an overall review of the affordability of this trip by the academy. This is because some trips require the school to pay non-refundable deposits for items such as tickets, accommodation or coaches prior to the trip. If your child is unable to attend the trip at very short notice then please be assured we will always do our best to find a student who can take their place, thus enabling us to afford refunds, but if we are unable to do this then we may be unable to offer refunds.

Behaviour: Places on the visit are subject to exemplary behaviour of your child as an ambassador of Bournville. Any breach in behaviour prior to the visit may result in your child being removed from the trip.

If any of your child's medical details have changed and you have not yet notified the school, please contact Mrs Bharj to request a new medical consent form. If your child has a medical condition, they must have their medication with them (e.g. inhaler or EpiPen) in order to attend the trip.
