Dear Parents and carers,

Children need to be in full school uniform. Depending on the weather, they may need a rain jacket or a hat and appropriate footwear.

We ask that your child bring a packed lunch. However, if they are entitled to free school meals then a packed lunch can be provided by the school.

Places on the visit are subject to exemplary behaviour of your child as an ambassador of Bournville. Any breach of behaviour prior to the visit may result in your child being removed from the trip.
