We are delighted to inform you that Year 6 will be attending a performance of: **Macbeth** at the **Alexandra Theatre, Birmingham** on **Monday, 3rd March 2025**.

The cost of the trip is £16 and this includes the cost of the theatre ticket and our train tickets into Birmingham.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to experience Shakespeare's work in a live theatre setting, enhancing their understanding of the play and bringing their learning to life. The play has been specially adapted to ensure that children can appreciate the wonders of Shakespeare while being fully immersed in a story they thoroughly enjoyed studying last term.

The trip will take place during the school day, with children returning to Bournville Train Station at **approximately 4:00 PM. Please arrange for your child to be collected from the station for this time if you are able.**

To secure your child's place, payment must be made by Tuesday, 25th February 2025. We understand that the cost of school trips can sometimes be challenging. If you have any concerns about payment, please do not hesitate to contact us in confidence. As a school, we are committed to ensuring that all children have the opportunity to take part, and we will do our best to support where possible.

Payment must be made securely online via ParentPay. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept cash or cheques. Please log into your child's ParentPay account, where the name of the educational visit will appear under "Pay for other items" before the deadline. If payment is not received by this date and no contact has been made with the school regarding this, tickets will be offered to other children.

Children are required to wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school. If you would like to order a school-packed lunch, please sign and return the attached form.

Please note that attendance on this trip is subject to exemplary behaviour. As representatives of Bournville, children are expected to uphold high standards. Any breach of behaviour prior to the visit may result in your child being withdrawn from the trip.
